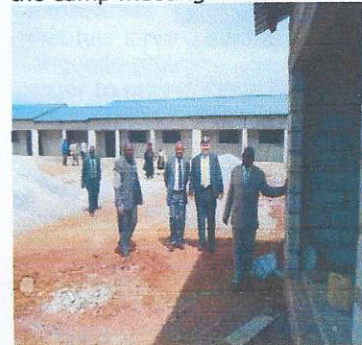
After a day's rest, Reverend John Masgrave and his wife set foot at church grounds where he was received by elders of the church and Elementary children.



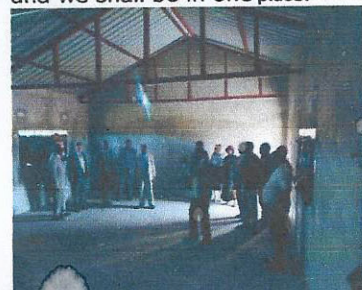
