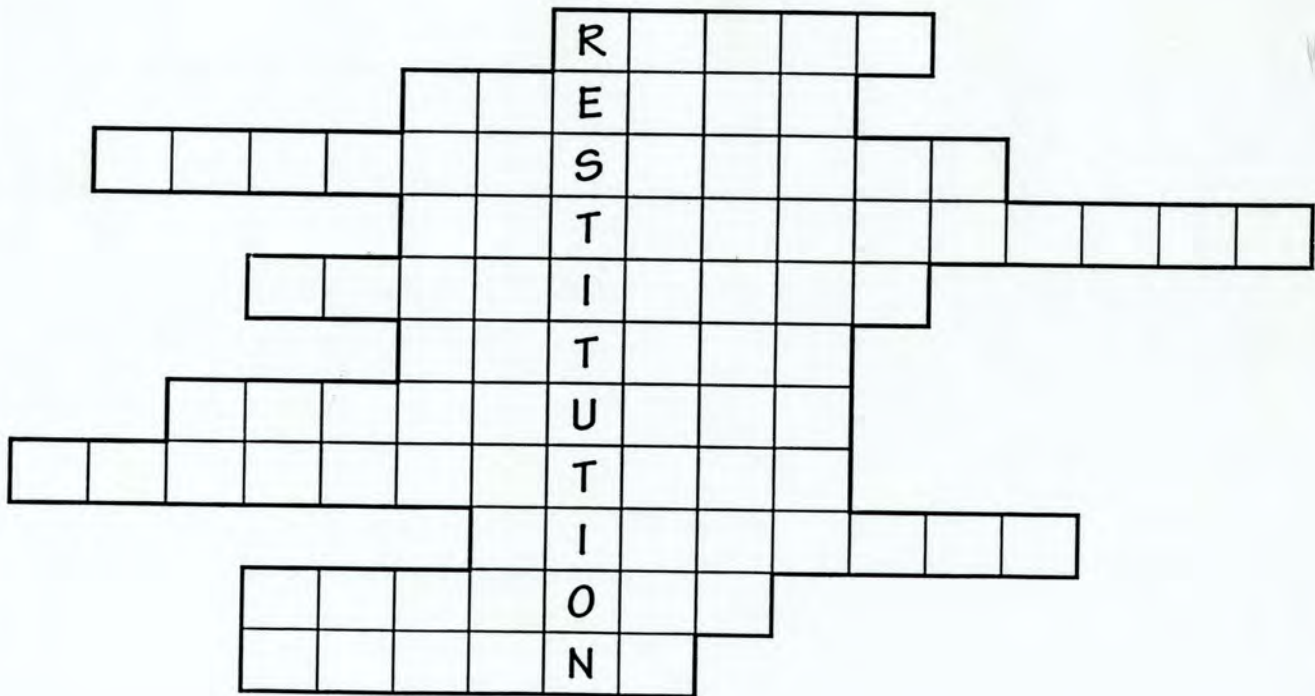

# But, Jesus Already Forgave Me!?!

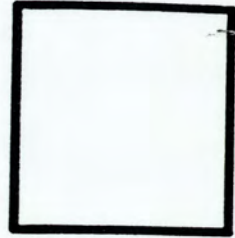
